SUBJECT: S-3 Narrative Report on Operational Mission, 5 December 1943.

- TO : Commanding Officer, 95th Bombardment Group, APO 634.
- 1. The 95th Bomb Group was alerted for this Mission at 2025, 4 December 1943. Bomb load to be 10 x 500 lb. G.P. bombs. The 13th Combat Wing was to form the 2nd Combat Wing of the 3rd Bomb Division formation. The 95th Group to fly low Group in 13th Combat Wing formation.
- 2. Twenty three (23) aircraft departed this base at 0750 to form the 95th Group. Three (3) aircraft departed this base to fly as spares for 390th "B" Group in Composite Wing formation. No difficulty was encountered in Group assembly as weather permitted a low altitude assembly. The three (3) aircraft to fly as spares for 390th "B" Group rendezvoused with 390th Group over their base at 8000.
- 3. The 95th Bomb Group proceded on course to Combat Wing rendezvous point and had slight difficulty in picking up the 100th (Lead Group) because of large number of Groups in that area. Combat Wing rendezvous was made and briefed course was held with slight variations. An undercast existed over much of the route over France and all targets were completely obscured. Bombs were dropped in the Channel on return flight.
- 4. Ship # 5918 piloted by Lt. Francis aborted from the formation just after take-off due to a runaway prop on # 4 engine. Ship # 1057 piloted by Lt. Reno returned to the base at 1145 having returned from 95th Group when no available vacancy existed for him. Ship # 0178 piloted by Lt. Witt returned to the base at 1215 having returned from the 390th "B" Group when no available vacancy existed for his ship. Ship # 7894 returned to this base at 1241 having aborted from 390th "B" Group due to # 1 engine cutting out.
- 5. The 95th Bomb Group sustained no battle damage and no injury to personnel. All aircraft returned safely to this base.
  - 6. Fighter rendezvous and cover was excellent.


