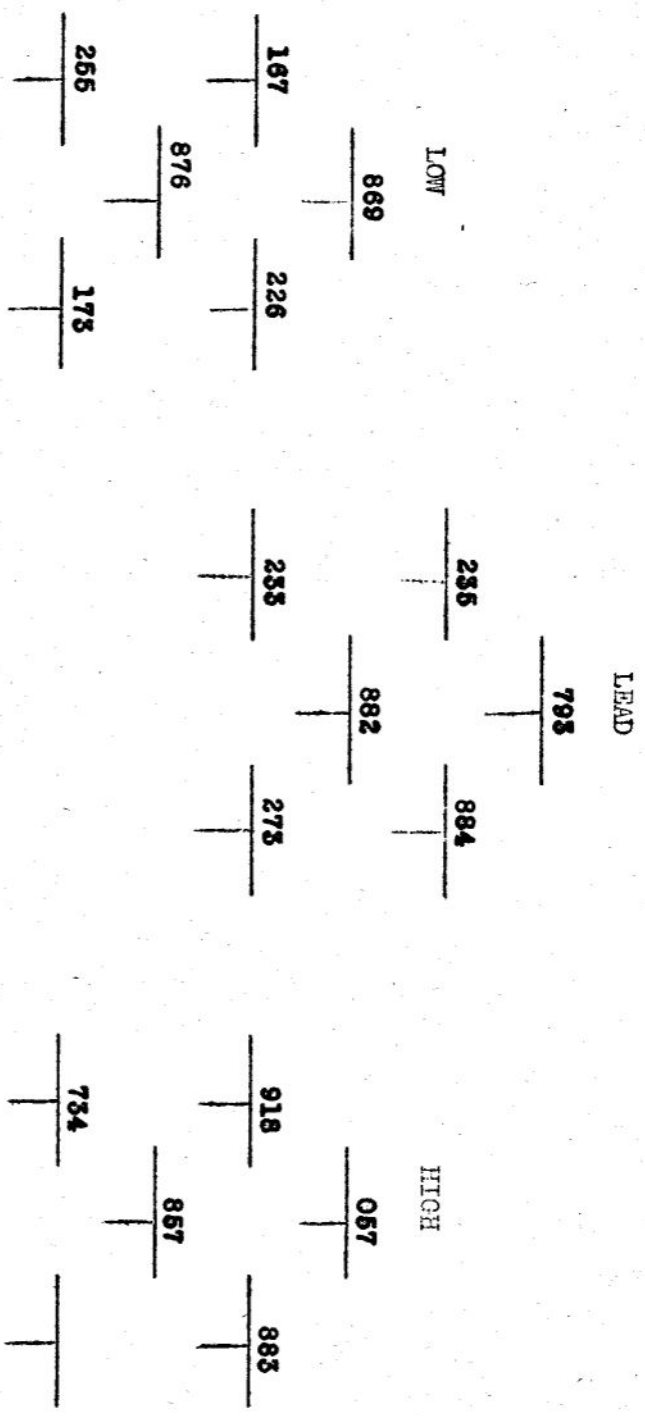


**95 B GROUP OVER TARGET

SUBJECT: Base Engineering Report on Combat Mission 16 December 1943.

TO : Commanding General, Third Bombardment Division (H), APO 634.
Commanding Officer, 95th Bombardment Group (H). Attn: Lt. Col.
MC KNIGHT, Base Operations.

1. The following information is submitted concerning combat mission of the 95th Bombardment Group (H) on 16 December 1943.

- a. Forty (40) B-17F airplanes took-off as per schedule.
- b. Thirty (30) B-17F airplanes returned to base after completion of mission.
- c. Eight (8) B-17F airplanes did not return to base.
 - (1) 42-3263 - Crash landed at Bungay.
 - (2) 42-6080 - Landed at Nutfield.
 - (3) 42-30674 - Landed at Metfield.
 - (4) 42-37734 - Landed at Thorpe Abbott.
 - (5) 42-30167 - Landed at Swanton Morley.
 - (6) 42-39883 - Landed at Thorpe Abbott.
 - (7) 42-30235 - Landed at Bungay.
 - (8) 42-30255 - Has not reported to home station.

2. There were two (2) abortive airplanes.

- a. 42-30322 - Air ducts blown out on #1, & #2 superchargers.
- b. 42-31054 - Excessive fuel pressure #1 engine. Suspected oil leak #2 engine.

3. All aircraft took-off as per schedule.

4. Battle damage is as follows:

- a. 42-37894 - Left outboard wing panel damaged.
- b. 42-6098 - Left wing panel damaged.
- c. 42-37857 - Sheet metal damage.
- d. 42-3095 - Right stabilizer damaged. (Self-inflicted by waist gunner)
- e. 42-30233 - Right stabilizer damaged. (Self-inflicted by waist gunner)
- f. 42-37882 - Control cable severed. Sheet metal damage.
