SUBJECT: Report of Operations Officer, Mission of 19 April 1944.

TO : Commanding Officer, 95th Bomb Group (H), APO 559.

MAIN 95TH GROUP FORMATION

1. GENERAL NARRATIVE. 25 aircraft including two spares of the Main 95 Group took off from base at 0645-0704 hours. Group assembly was effected over base at 2,000' as planned, climb to rendezvous altitude began at 0710. During the climb the 390A Group was identified and 95 Group tacked on as low Group in 13th Combat Wing. Saffron Waldron, Combat Wing assembly line, was reached at 0808 hours at 13,500'. The briefed control points to Division assembly was flown as ordered. Buncher #12 was crossed at 0818 at 13,500'. The formation during the climb remained closed up with no stragglers.

English coast was crossed at 0832 at 13,600', with bombing altitude being at 0855. Landfall on enemy coast was made at 53°40' - 04°37'E at 0913. The briefed course was flown to the target without incident. Fighter support was reported good the entire route in and out.

At the I.P. flares were fired indicating a visual run. Ground haze caused slight trouble with immediate target identification. Bombs were dropped on primary target at 1029 from 17,000! with good results.

Rally was made as briefed and course from the target was followed as directed. Good Combat Wing formation was reported as well as Group formations within the Wing.

The enemy coast was recrossed at 1156 at 17,000° and let down to minimum altitude began at that time. Orfordness was reached at 1222 at 5,000° and 95 Group returned to base at 1230. Landings were from 1231-1250 hours.

2. AIRCRAFT NOT ATTACKING. 23 aircraft including 2 spares left base in formation shown in attached Diagram "A". Spare a/c #42-7882 and 7988 turned back before becoming dispatched. 21 a/c were dispatched and are credited with sorties.

21 a/c went over the target in the formation shown in attached Diagram "B". All a/c over the target bombed without mechanical failure.

3. AIRCRAFT LOST. None.

95TH-39Oth-10Oth GROUP COMPOSITE FORMATION
1. GENERAL NARRATIVE. 7 a/c took off from base from
0621-0626 with instructions to join the 390B Group as High
Squadron. The Composite was the high Group in the 13 Combat
Wing. The Composite Equadron joined the 390B Group over
Buncher #11 at 4000 as briefed.

Reference is made to the report of 390B Group for a general narrative of the remainder of the mission, which was flown in company with 390B Group.

2. AIRCRAFT NOT ATTACKING. All 7 a/c put by 95 Group were dispatched and are credited with sorties.

7 a/c bombed primary target without mechanical failure.

3. AIRCRAFT LOST. None.
